## Would you like a Music Industry Careers Event at your school?

Wiltshire Music Connect has commissioned [Riverbank Studios](#) to tour an exciting, interactive **Music Industry Careers Event** for young people and their parents / carers, linked to local and national [resources](#).

### What does a Music Industry Careers Event involve?

- A facilitated panel discussion, networking opportunities and audience Q&A for up to 60 attendees.
- We'll book a panel of industry professionals and provide all resources and sound equipment.
- Panel members will include music industry professionals from a range of backgrounds talking about their experiences and giving advice on music careers.
- All attendees will be given a printed resource sheet with links to sources of further information.

### How much does it cost?

The full cost of an event is £1,000 but for 2019-20 a Wiltshire Music Connect subsidy reduces this to £600 for the first six school that book.

It's up to you how you raise this money. You might fund it through your school music or careers budgets. You might sell tickets to students (for example, 60 tickets @ £10). Or you might do a combination of both (£300 from school budgets plus 60 tickets @ £5.)

**We would encourage you to invite partner schools to attend.** You are welcome to sell tickets to them at whatever price you decide. You can even try to generate a surplus so that you have some money for your music department at the end.

The only thing we ask is that no student is excluded because they cannot afford to buy a ticket. The Wiltshire Music Connect subsidy (see above) is provided on the understanding that you will provide some low cost or free places for disadvantaged students.

### What will my school need to provide?

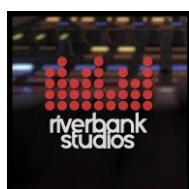
- A room or hall with a power supply and enough seating for all attendees and the panel
- A data report at the end of the event to confirm the number of attendees (Wiltshire and non-Wiltshire) parents, teachers, schools etc. (template provided)

### When will my event happen?

You can request an event for any time during the academic year 2019-20 – but you'll need to contact Riverbank Studios to make a booking before Christmas 2019. Remember that the subsidy is only available to the first 6 schools that book so contact Riverbank asap to avoid disappointment.
