CRITERIA

When you are writing about the person you are nominating, please remember to tell us how they meet the criteria. Don't just tell us they are great, we need to see clearly what it is that makes them so great! Take the time to tell us how they make you, their pupils, the team they work with feel, what initiatives have they taken to make music accessible and inclusive, what do they do that makes them so inspiring and motivating? What is it about their lessons or practice that makes it so fun?

1. Wiltshire Primary School Music Teacher of the Year 2022

Nominees must:

- Work in a Wiltshire School
- Have engaged with Wiltshire Music Connect over the past academic year
- Demonstrate a dedication to Primary School music that inspires and motivates others
- Demonstrate an excellent standard of teaching and learning within National Curriculum music and extra-curricular music
- Have an inclusive approach to music which benefits the whole school

Who can nominate: Any adult, over the age of 18, can make a nomination providing they have knowledge of the skills and achievements of the person they are nominating. For example, nominations can be made by Headteachers, Governors, Teachers, School Support Staff, Parents etc.

2. Wiltshire Secondary School Music Teacher of the Year 2022

Nominees must:

- Work in a Wiltshire School

- Have engaged with Wiltshire Music Connect over the past academic year
- Demonstrate a dedication to Secondary School music that inspires and motivates others
- Demonstrate an excellent standard of teaching and learning within National Curriculum music and extra-curricular music
- Have an inclusive approach to music which benefits the whole school
- Have shared their good practice with other schools and/or music teachers

Who can nominate: Any adult, over the age of 18, can make a nomination providing they have knowledge of the skills and achievements of the person they are nominating. For example, nominations can be made by Headteachers, Governors, Teachers, School Support Staff, Parents etc.

3. Wiltshire Inspirational Singing Leader 2022

Nominees must:

- Work in Wiltshire
- Have engaged with Wiltshire Music Connect over the past academic year
- Inspire young people to sing
- Show a commitment to inclusive singing
- Encourage children and young people to progress and/or perform vocally
- Demonstrate an excellent standard of vocal teaching and learning

Who can nominate: Any adult, over the age of 18, can make a nomination providing they have knowledge of the skills and achievements of the person they are nominating. For example, nominations can be made by Parents, Music Leaders, Headteachers, Governors, Teachers, School Support Staff etc.

4. Outstanding Individual Contribution to Music Education in Wiltshire 2022

Nominees must:

- Work in Wiltshire
- Contribute to / have a track record of contributing to music opportunities for children and young people in Wiltshire (in or outside schools) over a sustained period of time
- Have an established relationship with Wiltshire Music Connect
- Show a dedication to music education that inspires and motivates others
- Have an inclusive approach to their work
- Be reflective in their practice
- Continually strive for excellence in music education

Who can nominate: Any adult, over the age of 18, can make a nomination providing they have knowledge of the skills and achievements of the person they are nominating. For example, nominations can be made by Parents, Music Leaders, Headteachers, Governors, Teachers, School Support Staff etc.

5. Wiltshire Music Connect Associate Provider of the Year 2022

Nominees must:

- Work in Wiltshire
- Be a current, active member of the Associate Provider scheme
- Contribute to / have a track record of contributing to music opportunities for children and young people in Wiltshire (in or outside schools)
- Have engaged with Wiltshire Music Connect over the past academic year
- Show a dedication to music education that inspires and motivates others
- Have an inclusive approach to their work
- Regularly shares good practice with their peers and contributes to the Associate network

Who can nominate: Any adult, over the age of 18, can make a nomination providing they have knowledge of the skills and achievements of the person they are nominating. For example, nominations can be made by Parents, Music Leaders, Headteachers, Governors, Teachers, School Support Staff etc.

6. Wiltshire Inclusive Music Award 2022

Nominees must:

- Work in Wiltshire
- Have engaged with Wiltshire Music Connect over the past academic year
- Demonstrate a dedication to Inclusive music education that inspires and motivates others
- Demonstrate an excellent standard of teaching and learning
- Have an inclusive approach to music which benefits all learners
- Be a champion for inclusive music practice
- Regularly shares inclusive practice with their peers

Who can nominate: Any adult, over the age of 18, can make a nomination providing they have knowledge of the skills and achievements of the person they are nominating. For example, nominations can be made by Parents, Music Leaders, Headteachers, Governors, Teachers, School Support Staff etc.

7. Music Educator of the Year – Young Peoples' Choice 2022

The person you are nominating must:

- Work in Wiltshire
- Have inspired you and make music fun - maybe they have an amazing singing voice that makes you want to practice and be as good as them? maybe they can play a piece you like really fast that makes you

want to practice? perhaps you have started playing an instrument because of this person or taken part in shows that you might not have done? Maybe this person is really good at helping you to explore new styles of music?

- Are enthusiastic and make sure everyone has a chance to take-part
- Have supported you to feel good about your music making and confident to keep learning new things

Who can nominate: Any child or young person, aged 18 years or under, can make a nomination, as long as they have the appropriate parent/carer consent.
