

Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster Summary of Activity in Academic Year 2023-24

The Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster is made up of 21 schools.
The Music Cluster Coordinator is Steph Farr.

Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster in numbers:

- 15 of the schools engaged regularly in the music cluster.
- 7 of the schools received a Music Challenge and Support Visit from the Cluster Coordinator.
- Staff from 10 of the schools attended Music Cluster Meetings.
- Pupils from 10 schools participated in the Marlborough & Pewsey Cluster Music Project.
- Staff from 9 of the schools attended CPD provided by Wiltshire Music Connect.
- 15 of the schools had Wiltshire Music Connect Associates providing instrumental and vocal tuition.
- 10 schools accessed a reduced price Charanga Licence through Wiltshire Music Connect.
- 5 schools received a grant through Wiltshire Music Connect's School Music Development Fund.
- 1 schools were awarded Sing Wiltshire Status to recognise their singing achievements.
- 0 schools received a free Singing Leader visit.
- 3 schools received a free or subsidised music performance funded by Wiltshire Music Connect Associate musicians (Hear that Sound).
- 0 schools received subsidised STEAM workshops from Conductive Music.
- 11 schools have used Wiltshire Music Connect's School Music Development Plan template.

Wiltshire Music Connect invested a total of £10,944.65 in Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster during 2023-24. This included:

- £4,061.50 for cluster co-ordination, project activity and CPD for cluster members.
- £1,139.10 on subsidising First Access provision costs in the cluster schools.
- £3,424.05 for instrumental and vocal tuition subsidy for disadvantaged and vulnerable learners in the cluster schools.
- £2,320 in grants for school music development.

Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster Project:

10 schools took part in this cluster project and were able to access a 40 minute music performance for the whole school by visiting musicians. The performance included an introduction to contemporary music on percussion and guitars. The musicians performed well known songs with pupils actively participating. A class workshop followed this performance where pupils were given the opportunity for taster session on drums and guitar.
