

My Music Progression Plan Guidance for Parents/Carers

What is 'My Music Progression Plan'?

Wiltshire Music Connect's 'My Music Progression Plan' provides a new way of recording and celebrating progress in vocal and instrumental lessons. We hope that using this plan will help parents and carers feel more involved in their child's musical journey, and strengthen communication between Associate Tutors, schools, pupils, and parents and carers.

How will my child use this plan?

Together with their Associate Tutor, your child will identify a personal goal for their vocal or instrumental learning. They will then plan for how to achieve that goal, record their progress and achievements, and finally consider where this might take them next.

How can I be involved?

You can get involved with this process by reading the plan and discussing it with your child. There is space on page 3 for you to write a comment about how your child is progressing and anything you do to help them (like supporting practice at home, taking them to a concert, helping them join an ensemble, etc.). The blue box in Step 5 also contains links to information about other musical opportunities that you may wish to explore with your child.
