

GUIDANCE FLOWCHART

Do you have concerns about a child's welfare?

OR

Are you concerned that a colleague, member of staff, volunteer or contractor may have:

- behaved in a way that has harmed a child, or may have harmed a child? and/or
- possibly committed a criminal offence against, or related to, a child? and/or
- behaved towards a child or children in a way that indicates they may pose a risk of harm to children? and/or
- behaved or may have behaved in a way that indicates they may not be suitable to work with children.

Where a young person discloses abuse or neglect:

- Listen; take their allegations seriously, reassure that you will take action to keep them safe.
- Inform them what you are going to do next.
- · Do not promise confidentiality.
- Do not question further or approach / inform the alleged abuser.

LOCATION

A: Working in a school (during or outside of normal hours) or working for an organisation?

Make yourself aware of the school or organisations' procedures.

ARE

YOU:

Report immediately to the Designated Safeguarding Lead or a Senior Manager in that organisation.

Obtain an acknowledgement of your report/contact.

B: Working on your own where you are responsible for the activity?

You might be at your home or premises; at a pupil's home or in a community setting.

REPORT

Report the allegation within one working day:

- Concerns about adults
 Ask to speak to the Local Authority
 Designated Officer (LADO):

- Concerns about young people Integrated Front Door (IFD): 0300 456 0108
- Out of Hours Duty number for both:
