

## Tidworth Music Cluster Summary of Activity in Academic Year 2023-24

The Tidworth Music Cluster is made up of 11 schools.  
The Music Cluster Coordinator is Catherine Brentnall.

### Tidworth Music Cluster in numbers:

- **10** of the schools engaged regularly in the music cluster.
- **6** of the schools received a Music Challenge and Support Visit from the Cluster Coordinator.
- Staff from **7** of the schools attended Music Cluster Meetings.
- Pupils from **7** schools participated in the Tidworth Cluster Music Project.
- Staff from **6** of the schools attended CPD provided by Wiltshire Music Connect.
- **8** of the schools had Wiltshire Music Connect Associates providing instrumental and vocal tuition.
- **6** schools accessed a reduced price Charanga Licence through Wiltshire Music Connect.
- **2** school received a grant through Wiltshire Music Connect's School Music Development Fund.
- **0** schools were awarded Sing Wiltshire Status to recognise their singing achievements.
- **1** school received a free Singing Leader visit.
- **0** schools received a free or subsidised music performance funded by Wiltshire Music Connect Associate musicians.
- **3** schools received subsidised STEAM workshops from Conductive Music.
- **6** schools have used Wiltshire Music Connect's School Music Development Plan template.

### Wiltshire Music Connect invested a total of **£7,769.07** in Tidworth Music Cluster during 2023-24. This included:

- **£3,819.50** for cluster co-ordination, project activity and CPD for cluster members.
- **£265.65** on subsidising First Access provision costs in the cluster schools.
- **£2,965.92** for instrumental and vocal tuition subsidy for disadvantaged and vulnerable learners in the cluster schools.
- **£718** in grants for school music development.

### Tidworth Music Cluster Project:

The Tidworth Music Cluster Project for 23-24 involved live performances by the British Army Bands. The Band and the Bugles of the Rifles gave a performance that was attended by several schools, and further touring performances included a saxophone quartet and brass quintet from the Band and the Bugles of the Rifles and the British Army Band Tidworth visiting other cluster schools.

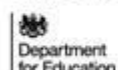
