

Warminster Music Cluster Summary of Activity in Academic Year 2022-23

The Warminster Music Cluster is made up of 13 schools. The Music Cluster Coordinator is Emily Askew.

Warminster Music Cluster in numbers:

- 10 of the schools engaged regularly in the music cluster.
- 7 of the schools received a Music Challenge and Support Visit from the Cluster Coordinator.
- Staff from 8 of the schools attended Music Cluster Meetings.
- Pupils from 9 schools participated in the Warminster Cluster Music Projects.
- Staff from 7 of the schools attended CPD provided by Wiltshire Music Connect.
- 2 of the schools had Wiltshire Music Connect Associates providing instrumental and vocal tuition.
- 5 schools accessed a reduced price Charanga License through Wiltshire Music Connect.
- 2 schools received a grant through Wiltshire Music Connect's School Music Development Fund.

Wiltshire Music Connect invested a total of £5,866 in Warminster Music Cluster during 2022-23. This included:

- £4,038 for cluster co-ordination, project activity and CPD for cluster members.
- £1,228 on subsidising First Access provision costs in the cluster schools.
- £600 in grants for school music development.

Warminster Music Cluster Projects:

The 2022-23 Warminster Music Cluster projects involved schools enjoying performances from Welsh Brass Band, as well as taking part in a collaborative singing event at the Minster fete.
