

Westbury Music Cluster

Summary of Activity in Academic Year 2022-23



The Westbury Music Cluster is made up of 8 schools.
The Music Cluster Coordinator is Emily Askew.

Westbury Music Cluster in numbers:

- **7** of the schools **engaged regularly in the music cluster.**
- **1** of the schools received a **Music Challenge and Support Visit** from the Cluster Coordinator.
- Staff from **7** of the schools attended **Music Cluster Meetings.**
- Pupils from **7** schools participated in the Westbury **Cluster Music Project.**
- Staff from **6** of the schools attended **CPD** provided by Wiltshire Music Connect.
- **5** of the schools had Wiltshire Music Connect Associates providing instrumental and vocal tuition.
- **5** schools accessed a **reduced price Charanga License** through Wiltshire Music Connect.
- **1** school received a **free performance** from Wiltshire Music Connect Associate musicians (Salisbury Area Music Coop).

Wiltshire Music Connect invested a total of **£9,207** in Westbury Music Cluster during 2022-23. This included:

- **£3,136** for cluster co-ordination, project activity and CPD for cluster members.
- **£1,073** on subsidising First Access provision costs in the cluster schools.
- **£4,998** for instrumental and vocal tuition subsidy for disadvantaged and vulnerable learners in the cluster schools.

Westbury Music Cluster Project:

The 2022-23 Westbury Music Cluster project was an interactive concert presenting Folk Music from the UK and beyond. Pupils from 7 different schools were treated to the sounds of 10 different instruments and participated in singing and dancing.
